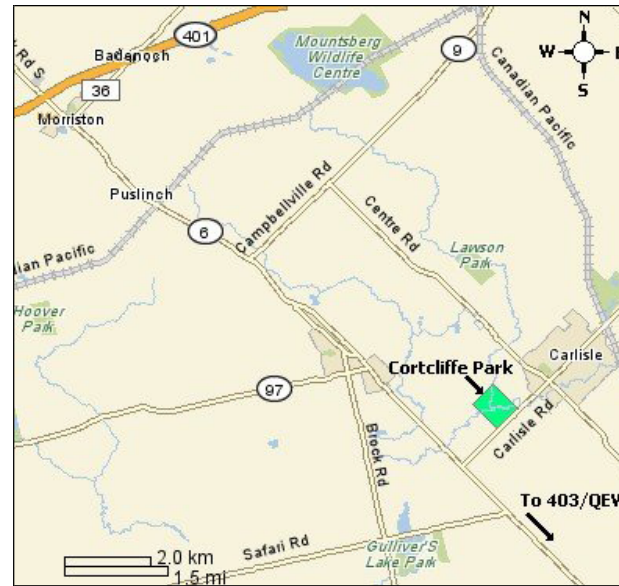

Driving Instructions

From Hamilton Take the 403 east, head North on Hwy 6 (Guelph). Pass Dundas Street (Hwy 5), continue north to Carlisle Road. Head East (right) on Carlisle Rd. The park will be on the north side.

From Kitchener/Waterloo Take the 401 East to Hwy 6 South (Hamilton). Head south to Carlisle Road, head east (left) onto Carlisle Road. The park is on the north side.

From Downtown Toronto Take the QEW/403 towards Hamilton. Head north on Hwy 6 (Guelph) to Carlisle Road. Head east (right) onto Carlisle Road. The park is on the north side.

Courtcliffe Park is in Carlisle between Centre Road and Hwy 6. Carlisle is north of Waterdown and is also accessible from Hamilton Street in Waterdown. Hamilton Street turns into Centre Road.

Who & What is FORCE ?

FORCE is Friends of Rural Communities & the Environment.

This citizens' group was formed in May 2004 to oppose an application, to establish Canada's 8th largest industrial open pit mine.

The quarry will negatively impact popular bike routes in Flamborough, Campbellville, Carlisle, Freelon, Kilbride and Milton.

How Does This Quarry Affect Cyclists ?

- * We will be sharing the road with a significant increased number of huge aggregate hauling trucks.
- * The proposed number of truck trips per day is equal to a truck every 30 seconds.
- * Narrow or non-existing road shoulders, numerous grade changes and limited site lines increase the risk to riders.
- * Spilt gravel on road surfaces, exhaust fumes and dust will change the landscape that we all enjoy.
