Quarry consultation to begin

FLAMBOROUGH (Mar 5, 2009)

St. Marys Cement Inc. says the formal consultation process for its Flamborough quarry application will begin with a notice to be published in a local newspaper late this month or early in April.

The company announced this week that the Ministry of Natural Resources has deemed its application complete after sending it back once for further information.

That means the company can publish the notice, starting a 45-day consultation period during which it will hold a public meeting at a time and place yet to be determined.

In the meantime, St. Marys says, it will post site plans and all available technical reports at flamboroughquarry.ca so the public can review them.

The application is for a limestone quarry on 158 hectares at 11th Concession and Milborough Line.

FORCE, a citizens group opposing the plan, has its own website, stopthequarry.ca.
