Temporary Full Outdoor Water Use/Watering Ban for the Community of Carlisle

Dear Resident,

In order to continue to provide the community of Carlisle with a sufficient water supply for daily household use, essential needs and fire protection, it has become necessary for the City of Hamilton to institute a **temporary full outdoor water use/watering ban for 10 days**. The City will utilize this 10 day period to complete the final upgrades to the Carlisle system in hopes that this will alleviate any future water shortages.

Residents who receive municipal water services are prohibited from running their lawn watering systems, washing their cars, sidewalks and driveways and filling their pools.

Flower and vegetable gardens can be watered by hand, with a watering can, as required, is permitted.

Residents **contravening the above water restriction** will receive a warning on a first offence, an immediate \$305 fine for a second offence, and a maximum fine of up to \$5,000 for a third offence under the Provincial Offences Act. City of Hamilton By-law enforcement officers will be patrolling these areas to ensure compliance with the ban

Once again the City appreciates your patience and support. This water restriction will be reviewed at the end of the 10 day period.
