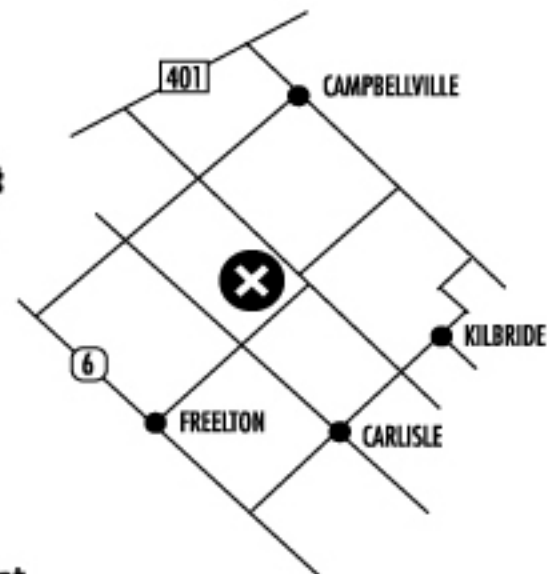

JUST THE FACTS

- Lowndes Holdings Corp. has acquired properties on Concession 11 East for the development of a large open pit mine.
- The land which Lowndes Holdings Corp. has acquired contains or is alarmingly close to provincially significant wetlands, Bronte Creek, and large aquifer(s). These aquifers provide much, if not all, of the drinking water to community wells in Carlisle, Freerton, Campbellville, Kilbride and private wells in rural areas.
- With over 380 acres, the developer expects around 1,000 truck trips daily at the proposed quarry. That could translate to be roughly one truck rumbling past your house every 45 seconds.
- Concerns over the potential impacts of a quarry include the destruction of our local environment, significant increases in truck traffic, pollution (air, noise, water, light), decrease in home and property values and the depletion and or contamination of our drinking water.
- The community has approved a committee (FORCE) to initiate and guide the opposition to the proposed quarry.
- This committee needs your support today to retain the legal and technical experts necessary to preserve our community.
