POLICY STATEMENT:

The Corporation is committed to and respects the privacy of the community and will strive to protect any personal information given to it by individuals in the community.

SCOPE:

All Directors, Members, Volunteers and Agents of the Corporation.

PROCEDURE:

Personal information (i.e. name, address, email address, phone number etc.) collected by Directors, Members, Volunteers and Agents of the Corporation will only be used for the purpose for which the information was collected and will be deleted from the Corporation's records once the information is no longer required. The Corporation's purposes for collecting personal information include: fostering communication, fund-raising, petitioning local and provincial governments, statistical purposes, determining volunteer eligibility and legal/political opposition of the proposed open-pit mine. Such information will not be lent, sold or loaned to any individual or business which is not directly furthering the objectives of the Corporation.

ACCOUNTABILITY:

All Directors, Members, Volunteers and Agents of the Corporation are accountable to adhere to this policy as outlined. Breaches of the policy may result in termination of directorship, membership, volunteer status or contracts for goods and services and/or other sanctions.
