## MNR finds quarry application incomplete

FLAMBOROUGH (Feb 10, 2009)

St. Marys Cement's application for a large limestone quarry on Concession 11 East north of Carlisle has been deemed incomplete by the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources.

Diane Schwier, a ministry aggregate technical specialist, said yesterday she had asked the company for minor changes to its site plans and "I have also requested clarification on a few points. I cannot provide you with specifics as the application is not considered public at this time."

The quarry licence application was submitted Jan. 22. The ministry returned it before the end of a 20-day review period.

Councillor Margaret McCarthy, who represents the area, said the ministry will have another 20 days once the company resubmits the application.

She also e-mailed concerned constituents to say city officials are drafting a resolution for council asking that the application be rejected.
